



Vaccination Requirements

Boarding and veterinary industry groups such as the American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA) believe that a dog who is engaged in one-on-one contact with another dog such as boarding, daycare, and dog parks needs to receive a Bordetella (canine cough) vaccine every six months.

Following the recommendations of the AVMA, Canine Creature Comforts requires a Bordetella vaccine every six months instead of annually. The Bordetella vaccine administered twice a year greatly reduces the likelihood of Tracheobronchitis, also commonly referred to as canine (kennel) cough.

A summary of our other vaccination and health requirements follows below for your review.

Required Canine Vaccinations:

For the health and safety of our guests, all dogs must be current on their vaccinations prior to participating in Canine Creature Comforts Doggy Daycare, Doggy Sleepovers or Dog Training Classes.

Written proof of the following vaccinations are required for all guests*.

DHPPV (Distemper, Parvo, Parainfluenza)	Current one or three year vaccine required
Bordetella (Canine Cough / Kennel Cough)	<i>Required every six months. Please note: many veterinarians administer this vaccine only by request.</i>
Rabies	Current one, two or three year vaccine required

*We prefer vaccinations to be administered 7 days prior to check-in.

In addition to our vaccination policy, all dogs visiting Canine Creature Comforts (CCC) must meet the following criteria unless otherwise approved by CCC management:

- Neutered or spayed if older than 6 months old
- Dogs who are in good health (no fleas or ticks or contagious illnesses)
- Dogs who have been socialized with other dogs
